



Position: Contract Licensed Physical Therapist

The Contract Physical Therapist works as needed to ensure the identification and accommodation of ECI eligible children and their families. The Physical Therapist is responsible for evaluation and/or treatment programming for infants and toddlers who live in the catchment area of the program. He/she is responsible for active treatment and documentation of service delivery/need.

Essential Duties/Responsibilities Include:

- Participate as a member of the Interdisciplinary Team (IDT) to evaluate and determine eligibility for ECI services
- Design and implement therapeutic intervention activities and/or family education as a member of the IDT to meet the individualized needs of children and families
- Provide training to the program personnel, consultants and families as a member of the IDT on motor/reflex development, range of motion, positioning, sensory, and assistive technology devices/services (procurement and maintenance).

Required Liability Insurance:

Professional Consumer Services (Individual) –Non- Physician: All individuals providing these services will be required to provide a current certificate of professional liability (\$500,00/\$1,000,000), general liability (premises/operations-\$500,00/\$1,000,000). If rendering services strictly on the center’s premises, the general liability is not required.

Education/License:

Bachelor’s degree from an accredited college or university with major course in the field of Physical Therapy plus one year as a licensed therapist or a Master’s degree with related work experience. Current license from the Texas State Board of Physical Therapy; Texas Driver’s License; Qualifications to obtain authorization to bill for therapeutic services; Experience in Early Childhood with special needs children or in an educational setting preferred.

Compensation/Contract Rate:

\$55/per documented visit; no benefits included in contract positions; paid by Texana Center (therapist is not required to bill external sources)
