

# ADULT ACCESS TO SERVICES

Texana will assist adults in addressing their needs arising from depression, schizophrenia and bipolar disorder.

## Who is eligible to receive services?

A resident of one of the six counties served (Fort Bend, Austin, Waller, Colorado, Wharton, Matagorda) who:

- has been diagnosed with Schizophrenia, **or**
- has been diagnosed with Major Depression, **or**
- has been diagnosed with Bipolar Disorder, **and**
- is at least 18 years of age.

## How do I get help?

Individuals seeking treatment should contact the nearest Behavioral Healthcare Outpatient Clinic to make an appointment for an assessment/eligibility determination. In order to be seen, you will need to bring the following:

- Medicaid card, Medicare card, private insurance card
- Driver's license
- Social security card
- Proof of income (IRS 1040 or 1040 EZ form, paycheck stubs, etc.)
- Number of individuals in the household
- Utility bill showing that you live in one of the six counties that we serve
- Records of any unusual expenses

***If you do not bring these items, you will be asked to reschedule.***
