FY 2018

September 2017 thru August 2018

Fiscal Year 2018 started out in recovery mode from Hurricane Harvey. From minor leaks to two of our Behavioral Healthcare Clinics sustaining considerable damage. About 50 of our employees were also affected. Recovery efforts lasted several months, but Texana was fortunate to have been awarded approximately \$1,059,800 from Rebuild Texas, Americares and FEMA to assist with rebuilding, damages and medication restock.

November saw the rebirth of the Texana Trot 5K Fun Run! It had been several years since the last event on our campus in Rosenberg and there was lots of excitement surrounding the return. Held in Fulshear, the event saw a record of over 240 participants and raised almost \$20,000 for the Forward Together in Fulshear Capital Campaign

The Forward in Fulshear Capital Campaign met a major milestone during FY18 with the ceremonial groundbreaking of the new Texana Fulshear Campus. Approximately 75% of donations were earmarked for the Fulshear campaign signifying that the campaign had raised \$1.5 million.

Texana Center was the beneficiary for several events with the most notable being the eighth annual Scarecrow Festival hosted by Cross Creek Ranch by Johnson Development. This was the start of a valued partnership and by the end of the fiscal year saw the start of the very first Texana Social Connections Club for teens and young adults with autism. Cross Creek Ranch was instrumental in this as they loaned us their conference room for these weekly meetings until the day that our Fulshear building could open.

In the spring, Texana's Behavioral Healthcare Services received a grant from the Texas Health and Human Services Commission in collaboration with Fort Bend County to provide services to adults who have been incarcerated within the last 12 months, have serious and persistent mental illness and have experienced multiple psychiatric hospitalizations. Funding from the grant allows for use with transportation, transitional housing, emergency food and clothing.

We are grateful to all of our community partners and volunteers this past fiscal year. They help us to change the lives of our clients so that they can unlock their potential and lead happy, fulfilling and productive lives.
